There are some important requirements that you should be aware of before school starts. Until completed, your student will not be able to attend school.


Proof of the following is required:

- Up-to-date immunizations
 - o DPT
 - o Polio
 - o MMR
 - Varicella
- Lead screening
- Proof of residency
- Birth certificate

Copies of health examination forms are available in the school office or from your healthcare provider. We encourage you to make your appointments now! Many physicians will be full and unable to schedule an appointment in August.
