Accessible Services

Buses are accessible for persons using wheelchairs and other mobility devices. For persons unable to use regular transit service, paratransit (curb to curb) service is available. Eligibility for the paratransit services is determined by guidelines in the ADA. Requests for certification should be made to the DMT office.

Tickets for paratransit rides are 5 for \$6, (fares south of Tilton are higher) and are available only at the DMT office. To obtain paratransit rides, certified riders should call (217) 443-2999 at least 1 day in advance.
